Welcome athletes, coaches, and officials to the 2025 Virtus Swimming World Championships in Bangkok, Thailand. We are delighted to host you in our vibrant city and wish you a successful and enjoyable event. Bangkok, the capital and largest city of Thailand, is a bustling metropolis located on the delta of the Chao Phraya River. Known for its rich cultural heritage, Bangkok is a vibrant hub of commerce, politics, and tradition. Visitors can explore landmarks such as the Grand Palace, Wat Arun, and the iconic floating markets, alongside experiencing world-renowned Thai cuisine.

The 2025 Virtus Swimming World Championships will be organised by Virtus Swimming Championships Thailand, in collaboration with key national and international stakeholders.

Technical support for the championships will be provided by the Thailand Aquatics Association (TAA), ensuring adherence to international standards for competition and event management.

The Meaning of the Mascot

The mascot for the 2025 Virtus Swimming World Championships is **Macchanu**, a mythical character from Thai and Hindu mythology. Macchanu is the son of Hanuman and Suvannamaccha, embodying qualities of bravery, loyalty, and harmony between land and water.

Language

The official language of the championships is **English**. To assist non-English speaking teams, the LOC will assign volunteer translators.

Travel and Transportation

Visa Requirements

Participants from certain nations will require a visa to enter Thailand. It is the responsibility of each delegation to secure their visas prior to arrival. The LOC will provide invitation letters upon request to support visa applications.

Insurance

All participants, including athletes, coaches, and team officials, are required to arrange their own travel and medical insurance, covering any medical emergencies or incidents during their stay in Thailand.

4) Sports Rules and Regulations

All competitions will adhere strictly to **World Para Swimming Rules** and **Virtus Swimming Specifications**, ensuring fairness and consistency throughout the championships.

Entry Criteria

- Maximum of 3 entries per nation for individual events.
- 1 team entry (4 swimmers) per nation for relay events.
- Each athlete MUST qualify with at least one (1) MQS entry, all other entries for the athlete must meet at least the MET for the relevant event.
- All individual events of 400m or greater will be swum as Heat Declared Winner ("Timed Finals").
- Entry is subject to the <u>Virtus Conditions of Entry</u> and <u>Code of Conduct</u>, <u>Safeguarding</u> Code, and the <u>Virtus Privacy Policy</u>

Eligibility and Accreditation

Athletes must have full Virtus International eligibility in one of three Virtus II-1, II-2 or II-3 groups below. Accreditation (Event Credentials) will be issued to each athlete after she/he personally has shown her/his passport to the Virtus officer upon arrival. All staff members will also receive accreditations.

No guest entries will be permitted.

COMPETITION GROUP	ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA
Virtus II-1 (Paralympic S14 Class)	Athletes with an Intellectual Disability who have: 1) Full Scale IQ of 75 or lower on WAIS, WISC or Stanford Binet, 2) At least one domain area with significant limitations on a Vineland or ABAS Adaptive Behavior assessment, and 3) Onset before age 22.
Virtus II -2	Athletes with an intellectual disability and significant additional impairment (including Trisomy21 & Translocation Down Syndrome with AAI Clearance)
Virtus II-3	Athletes with a formal diagnosis of Autism (ASD) Note: Athletes with Autism who also meet the criteria for <i>Intellectual Disability</i> are eligible to compete in the Virtus II1/Paralympic S14 group above.

Results System

The event will use the **Hy Tek Meet Manager V8.0** system (confirmation pending) to manage and display competition results.



Wild Card Entry [for countries who have not previously attended a Virtus World Swimming event]

The application of Wild Card Entries by countries developing their Virtus sport swimming program is strongly encouraged. If in doubt contact the Virtus Sport Director-Swimming for information. These slots are aimed at encouraging wider participation, fostering the growth of competitive swimming globally, and providing opportunities for athletes who may not meet the standard qualification times.

Each application for a Wild Card entry will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Wild Card athletes must still meet basic eligibility requirements and adhere to event rules.

Member Organisations without any qualified athletes, or with only one (1) qualified athlete in the Championships can apply for a Wild Card. For Wild Card entry please contact the Virtus Swimming Director by 20 March 2025. Note that a Wild Card slot is allocated to the individual athlete, not to the respective Member Organisation.

A maximum of one (1) male slot and one (1) female slot may be granted if a Member Organisation has not obtained any qualification slot by MQS.

Member Organisations who have obtained only one (1) qualification slot may be given one (1) or two (2) Wild Card slots as per the table below:

Qualified Swimmers	Wild Card Slots available
No (0) qualified swimmers	1 female and/or 1 male slot
1 qualified female swimmer	1 female or 1 male slot
1 qualified male swimmer	1 female slot

Wild Card does not apply to our US Team since we have participated many times.







Medal Criteria

Medals will be awarded for **1st**, **2nd**, **and 3rd places** in each event. For events with fewer than 4 competitors, the medal distribution may be adjusted in accordance with the n-1 rule. For example, if there are only three swimmers in an event - only two medals will be awarded.

Anti-Doping

Random doping tests will be conducted under the supervision of the **Doping Control Agency of Thailand (DCAT)**, in accordance with international anti-doping regulations.

We will provide information in our USA Team Guide about extra paperwork called TUE's that may be needed for certain medications.

Accreditation

Accreditation will be issued upon identity verification and validation of eligibility. Accreditation must be worn at all times to access competition and official event areas.

Medical Provision

Comprehensive medical support will be available at all competition venues and official hotels, including emergency medical services and on-call physicians.

Entry cost

Team costs are unique to each Virtus member country traveling to Thailand.

USA NOTES: For the US National Team, Athletes Without Limits will be conducting an athlete interest & MQS survey of US swimmers with Virtus eligibility to help estimate US National Team size prior to setting the cost per athlete.

Once US Team costs are determined we will post our USA Team Guide.

EVENT FEE: Athlete costs will be an all-inclusive event registration fee that covers team accommodations (swimmers stay with our National Team Coaches and staff together with delegations from other countries), meals, credentials, event entry, ceremonies, event shuttles, uniforms, coaching and US Team support for 10 days in Thailand August 20-30, 2025.

FLIGHTS: Because we originate from many cities across the US, airfare to Thailand will be an additional cost that athletes will purchase directly – most US athletes fly with their parents/family to Virtus events and meet up with the Team at the Team Hotel.

FAMILIES: Parents and family members coming as spectators make their own separate hotel reservations near the venue and/or team hotel. We are typically able to provide some guidance on this based on recommendations from the host country and local organizing committee and will provide further information in our US Team Guide & Zoom sessions.
